This order shall dispose of two petitions bearing
CRM No.M-29374 of 2014 titled as *Sushil Kumari vs. State of Punjab
and others and CRM No.M-4306 of 2016* titled as *Anita Kumari vs. State
of Punjab*.

The prayer made in CRM No.M-29374 of 2014 is for
issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to hand over the

investigation of the case to some independent agency and prayer made in in CRM No.M-4306 of 2016 is for quashing of FIR No.173 dated 07.07.2014 registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

In compliance of the directions issued by this Court, learned State counsel has filed status report in Court and same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. It has been mentioned therein that during inquiry, Mehar Chand, Jagdip Singh, Vandana Dogra, Balbir Dogra, Sunny Dogra and Satish Kumar were found innocent and recommended for arrest of Anita Rani. It has also been mentioned in the status report that challan will be presented against Anita Kumari-petitioner in CRM No.M-4306 of 2016 after conclusion of the investigation and cancellation report will be filed against those persons who were found innocent during investigation.

In view of the status report filed by the State, nothing survives in these petitions and both the petitions are disposed of with a direction to do the needful as per status report filed today in Court.
