Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein his year of birth is mentioned as 1997 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as

08.11.1998. Both the petitioners have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Mansa (Annexure P-3) for protection of their life and liberty.

The mother of the girl requested the Court that she wants to have a talk with her daughter i.e petitioner No.2. She was allowed to meet her in my chamber. The girl flatly refused to accompany her and stated that she would go along with her husband i.e. petitioner No.1.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to take appropriate action on the representation (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioners.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
