Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.812 dated 24.06.2016 under Sections 420, 177 IPC and Section 187 of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, registered at Police Station City, Panipat, District Panipat.

This Court vide order dated 30.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/ Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 30.08.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Rajbir Singh, submits that in terms of aforesaid order, petitioner has joined investigation

and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 30.08.2016 are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
