The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.157 dated 28.09.2015, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC (Sections 376/506 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act added later on vide DDR No.31 dated 2.10.2015 and DDR No.19 dated 30.11.2015), Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner says that the petitioner is in custody since 01.10.2015.

Prosecutrix was missing from the house in the intervening night of 26/27.09.2015. She returned after three days. Her statement has been recorded in the Court where she has stated that they had been travelling in a train. The FSL report shows that there was no spermatozoa. Only 2

witnesses out of 20 witnesses have been examined till now. The trial is taking time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
