Present petition is for release of petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.36 dated 16.04.2015, under Sections 376-D and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that no offence is made out against the petitioner as he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing is to be recovered from him. Moreover, the proceedings of the trial Court has been stayed by this Court in a petition bearing CRM-M-33713-2015. So, he be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer, has informed that there are four complaints which were initiated by complainant Aarti Devi and one of the cases the accused had been acquitted

vide judgment (Annexure P-5) and the proceedings under Section 182

Cr.P.C. has been initiated against her (complainant). At present, only two complaints are pending.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

The petitioner is in judicial custody and no useful purpose would be served to further detain him in jail. The final conclusion of trial will take a long time.

In view of above facts, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge/Duty Magistrate, Pathankot.

Needless to mention that, nothing observed here-in-above, would reflect, on merits in the trial of the main case, in any manner.
