This is a petition for grant of regular bail in number of cases registered at different Districts. Similar application filed by the petitioner i.e. CRM-M-25719-2016, has been dismissed by this Court on 30.8.2016.

State counsel on the instructions of ASI Vinod Kumar informs that petitioner has not yet been arrested in cases registered at Palwal and Panipat, mentioned at Serial No.3 and 4 of headnote the petition.
