Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.160 dated 29.12.2015, registered at Police Station Division No.3, Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 471 IPC.

On 06.09.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that interim bail granted to the petitioner was cancelled on the ground that the petitioner did not join the investigation and prays that if one more opportunity is granted to him.

In the circumstances let the petitioner appear before the Investigating Officer on 13.09.2016 or on any other date on which his appearance is required by the Investigating Officer. On his appearance the I.O. shall release him on interim bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 05.10.2016.”

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Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.09.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
