The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of DDR No.042 in cross case bearing FIR No.33 dated 04.04.2016 registered under Sections 324, 323 427, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Adampur, Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar, in view of compromise dated 06.04.2016 Annexure P-2.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 31.08.2016 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court through District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offence and the fact that the cross case bearing FIR No.33 dated 04.04.2016 has been quashed, I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed in this case also.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-30342 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The DDR No.042 in cross case bearing FIR No.33 dated 04.04.2016 registered under Sections 324, 323 427, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar, is quashed qua the petitioners along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
