Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.48, dated 30.03.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1), along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated October 26, 2016, report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at a compromise. Even

amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.48, dated 30.03.2012, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Chhapar, District Yamuna Nagar, and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
