Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 20.05.2015 in a case registered on the statement of ASI Sukhwinder Singh on the allegations that the petitioner along with 7-8 other persons named in the FIR had formed a gang for committing theft of vehicles and purchase of total loss damaged vehicles and to sell them after forging the documents and affixing fake chasis and engine number besides changing the registration numbers. So far as the petitioner is concerned, the individual role is attributed to the petitioner that he was found in possession of four cars.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 20.05.2015. The trial is likely to take a long time.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
