The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 70 dated 21.9.2013 registered under Section 15/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station P.A.U., Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from ASI Shiv Kumar submits that the trial is at the fag end as even the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has also been recorded and now the case before the trial Court is fixed for 27.1.2016.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner.
