The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.139 dated 29.05.2015, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur, under Sections 353, 332, 186, 506 IPC.

Learned State counsel has stated that as per the allegations, the petitioner had assaulted the complainant, who was a Government servant and apart from that, he torn away the official receipt book, therefore, the matter cannot be compromised without the permission of the competent authority.

I find this argument to be meritorious.
