Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case FIR No. 25 dated 13.02.2016 under Sections 323,324,307,506,427,148,149 IPC registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar which was registered at the instance of Vinay Kumar on the allegations that on 12.02.2016, when the complainant along with his brother was present in the street, the petitioner along with 8-10 boys arrived over there on motorcycles, armed with kirpans and datar and assaulted the complainant. The co-accused of the petitioner, Gopi, who happens to be the brother of petitioner, is attributed grievous injury on the person of Vinay Kumar complainant. However, the petitioner has not been attributed any grievous injury. The injury attributed to the petitioner with kirpan on the back side of the head has been declared to be a simple injury as per the record brought by ASI, Sukhchain Singh.

Since the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 23.03.2016 and challan having been presented, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. In case the trial has not been assigned after commitment, the bail will be granted to the petitioner by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.
