This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") seeking issuance of direction to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in respect of murder of Abhishek Kumar @ Rahul, son of the petitioner.

2. The investigation in this case has been conducted by DSP, Sukhwinder Singh, District Kapurthala. After the registration of FIR under Sections 279, 304-A and 427 IPC, Police Station Satnampur Phagwara, District Kapurthala against Rimple Kumar-driver of the tractor No. PB-46-4755 and after the completion of investigation and presentation of report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. against the aforesaid Rimple Kumar, it is

pending disposal in the concerned Court.

3. In view of the submission of report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. after the completion of the investigation, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

4. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to take recourse to the other remedies availably to him under the law.
