The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.691, dated 17.8.2015, registered under Sections 452, 395, 397, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Model Town Panipat.

As per the allegations, the petitioner was one of a group persons who entered the farm house of the complainant and took 8 he-buffaloes and 2 she-buffaloes at gun point.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 4.9.2015 and the trial is no longer near conclusion.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Subhash Chander, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
