The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.80, dated 14.6.2011, registered under Section 420 of the IPC and Section 82 of the Registration Act, at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

On 7.9.2016, the following order was passed :-

“ This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.80, dated 14.06.2011 registered under Sections 420 IPC and 82 Registration Act at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in this case the sale took place in the year 2005. Thereafter the petitioner left for Australia and the FIR was lodged in the year 2011 and without ever issuing notice to the petitioner in Australia he was wrongly declared proclaimed offender. Moreover the matter has now been settled between the parties.

Learned Addl. A.G. on instructions from H.C.Narender Singh has accepted the fact that the original transaction was of 2005, FIR was lodged in the year 2011 and at that time the petitioner was in Australia and that now the matter has been compromised.

It is also stated that petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is pending and is now fixed for 13.09.2016.

Adjourned to 13.09.2016.

To come up alongwith ***CRM-M-7020 of 2016.***"

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Harmesh Singh, accepts that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within three weeks who shall release him on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of.
