The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.336 dated 16.05.2016 registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 506, 452, 325, 307 IPC.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 22.09.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been compromised. Learned DAG, on instructions from ASI Mahesh Pal, states that he has no knowledge about the same. Adjourned to 18.11.2016 to enable the investigating officer to confirm this fact.

In the meantime, let the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the investigating officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahesh

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Kumar has accepted the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 22.09.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
