The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 40 dated 06.02.2015 registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal under Sections 304-B, 306, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the private witnesses have been turned hostile. He further states that the petitioner is in custody since 27.02.2015 and the trial will take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
