Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite there being no case against the petitioner, he is being called by respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station B-Division, District Amritsar. He further states that since the petitioner was facing harassment at the hands of respondent No.3, he has submitted a representation dated 25.8.2016 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but still the petitioner is being called in the Police Station without considering the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the claim as put forward by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-7) and to act in accordance with law.
