The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.21, dated 18.2.2015, registered under Sections 21/22/61 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged recovery in this case is 216 grams of intoxicating powder, whereas the commercial quantity is 250 grams. The petitioner has been in custody for more than eight months and no other case under the NDPS Act is

pending against him.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh, Officiating Superintendent, Central Jail, Amrtisar has been filed. As per the same, the petitioner has undergone 8 months and 17 days of custody.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
