Petitioner Satbir has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.969 dated 22.09.2015, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. Vikas Chopra, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, petitioner-Satbir has impersonated himself as Rameshwar Dayal and produced one 'demand draft' amounting to Rs.53,11,997/-, issued by Vijaya Bank, Jhajjar. On the basis of complaint made by the Manager, the present FIR was lodged and the present petitioner was apprehended. From the record, I find that the amount has not been

given to the present petitioner and is lying in the account. The offences are triable by Magistrate. The petitioner is in custody since 23.09.2015. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
