The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.84,
dated 5.4.2016, registered under Sections 370, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471,
120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar.

As per allegations, the petitioner got prepared a false
passport of a child and sent him abroad.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is no
complaint of kidnapping of any child by the petitioner in the police

station and the petitioner has now been in custody for 4½ months.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
