This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.0042 dated 07.05.2016 registered under Sections 323/452/307/427/506/148/149 IPC and under Section 25/27/54/59 at Police Station-Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the injury attributed

to the petitioner was simple in nature and he has been in custody for three and a half months. The gun shot was attributed to one co-accused Sajjan Singh who is in jail.

Learned DAG Punjab on instructions from ASI Nahar Singh and learned counsel for the complainant are not in a position to deny this fact.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
