This petition has been filed for direction to the respondents to conduct a fair and effective investigation into the FIR No. 50 dated 21.03.2015 under Sections 302 IPC, registered at PS- Div.No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner has in possession of important evidence which was never considered by the police and police had filed a untraced report. However, on that a protest petition was moved by the petitioner. The court had rejected the untraced report and had taken cognizance.

The limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner would appear before IO and present the evidence in his

possession to the IO and IO should consider the same and if necessary file

an application under Section 173-A Cr.P.C.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh states that State have no objection to this course of action.

Petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the IO on 08.12.2016 between 10:00 am to 04:00 p.m and present the entire evidence in his possession and the police would consider that evidence and if necessary supplementary challan can be presented.
