Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent(s)-State to register a criminal case against respondent No.5 and further prayer for providing adequate protection to the petitioner so as to enable him to enter his own land without any fear and threat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-1), given to Deputy Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar, by the petitioner be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar, is directed to consider the said representation dated 24.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) himself/herself or get it considered through respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran; take appropriate action as per law and pass appropriate order within two month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
