Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the representation dated 27.8.2016 (Annexure P-5) is required to be addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but it was wrongly addressed to Senior Superintendent/Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana. He prays for necessary correction in this regard.

On his oral request, the prayer is allowed and the representation (Annexure P-5) is ordered to be treated as if the same has been addressed to respondent No.2. Registry to make necessary correction accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with

law. However, respondents No.5 to 7 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they had moved a representation (Annexure P-5) to the respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In view of the above, without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.
