JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for getting conducted the fair and thorough enquiry pertaining to the case bearing FIR No.067 dated 07.05.2016, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural registered against Jasmail Singh @ Jassa (her husband) at the instance of respondent No.4 as alleged to protect her life and liberty as well as family members at the hands of respondent No.4.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though detailed representation Annexure P-4 made to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ludhiana Rural way back in the month of July, 2016 but till date no action has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation (Annexure P-4).

The instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in Annexure P-4 and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
