In the present petition, prayer has been made for a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to initiate proceedings against respondent No.4 under section 182 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contends that a case was registered against the petitioner and five others on a false complaint filed by respondent No.4. Same was quashed on the ground that respondent No.4 had preferred a complaint containing similar allegations.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the considered view that present petition is misconceived. Needless to observe that it is open to the authority to examine whether in a case, proceedings under section 182 IPC had to be initiated on false information being furnished. This court would normally not give such a direction on the prayer made by an individual. There is no merit in the petition.

Dismissed.
