This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take action against respondent No.5 for embezzlement of Panchayat funds i.e. public money which runs into crores of rupees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated May 23, 2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar (Punjab) to decide his representation dated May 23, 2016 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.
