1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No.4 to 6 are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they had moved a representation dated 26.1.2016 (Annexure P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that though

representation (Annexure P-5) was sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, but it should have been addressed to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

At this stage, Mr. Rishu Mahajan, Advocate puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4. Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No.4 in Court today, is taken on record.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners move a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar within a week from today, the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar shall take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the said representation.

In the meantime, necessary order be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.
