Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the State has produced an affidavit furnished by petitioner No.1, namely Deepika Mittal aged 20 years daughter of Sh. Vinod Kumar Mittal wife of Sh.Sumit Kumar. A perusal of the affidavit shows that petitioner No.1-Deepika Mittal does not require any police protection. Said affidavit is taken on record.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the affidavit given by petitioner No.1, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their lives and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the SSP concerned, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
