Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Loveleen Kaur alleging that she is owner of 14 kanals 15 marlas of land and the petitioner in connivance with each other prepared a forged lease agreement dated 30.4.2011 with the help of witnesses. A civil suit has been filed by her in which said agreement has been declared to be forged.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that an appeal is pending against the said decision. Petitioner No.1 has joined investigation. Petitioner No.2 is stated to be unable to speak.

Taking into consideration, the above said facts, I am of the considered opinion that it is not a case where custodial interrogation is required.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 19.11.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
