The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 25.8.2012 for having been found in possession of 1 Kg 200 grams of heroin, recovered from his co-accused Harkanwaljit Singh.

State counsel has not been able to justify the period of four years for not producing the evidence.

The petition is disposed of with a direction that trial Court shall make an earnest endeavor to conclude the case within a period of six months and in case the trial is not concluded qua the petitioner within a period of six months, the petitioner shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
