For having been found in possession of 2800 tablets of MICROLIT, the petitioner along with two other accused was apprehended by the police while coming in a car. Earlier an application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by this Court on 23.02.2016 with an observation that in case, the trial is not concluded within a period of six months after the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again. After expiry of six months, the petitioner has again filed the present petition.

On asking of the Court, learned State counsel informs that no witness has been examined till date.

In view of the period of detention of petitioner for a period of approximately one and half year without any witness having been

examined, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
