Perusal of the police file indicates that the petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of telephonic conversation and is alleged to have received a sum of Rs.5,000/- from the complainant.

Since the petitioner has been involved during the course of investigation after recovery of tainted money, having been received from the Reader of SHO, was effected and the petitioner having joined investigation, he can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required; he will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner; he will give his voice sample as undertaken on his behalf by his counsel, in case required and he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of, during the entire period of trial.
