Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and have married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have approached this Court for protection.

The petitioners appear to have filed a representation to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-5.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

The matter is covered by the judgment of this Court in **Pradeep Kumar Vs. State of Haryana, 2008 (3) RCR (Criminal) 376.**

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana would look into representation Anneuxre P-5 and will ensure that the petitioners are not forcibly taken in custody by any of the respondents on the allegation that petitioner No.2 has been

kidnapped or abducted by petitioner No.1. In case of any imminent threat to the petitioners, it will be open to them to approach the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana for appropriate protection. In case, the petitioners are to be taken in custody on any complaint of respondents No.4 and 5, the petitioners will be given an advance notice of 15 days by respondents No.1, 2 and 3 in order to enable them to protect their liberty.
