**This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the
petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.69, dated
11.06.2016 registered under Sections 324/326/34 IPC (offence under
Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Dhariwal, District**

Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that it was actually a fight where the petitioner had suffered more serious injuries than the complainant but no action was taken against the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant and the learned Additional A.G. state that as per the inquiry it was found that the injuries suffered by the petitioner could be inflicted by friendly hand.

In my opinion, almost all injuries which a person can be suffered can be suffered by a friendly hand and in the absence of only explanation in the FIR, I do not deem it appropriate to deny anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 22.09.2016 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. On his appearance the I.O. shall release him on bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioner does not appear before the investigating

officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
