This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.109 dated 02.09.2014, under Section 376 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 03.09.2015, while granting interim bail to the petitioner, it was observed that he and the prosecutrix had an affair for three years and thereafter, the boy (petitioner) refused to marry her. The prosecutrix is 32 years of age.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that there are 12 prosecution witnesses, out of which two have been examined. The prosecutrix has been examined-in-chief. A Special

Investigating Team was constituted on 08.01.2015 and thereafter, the

challan has been presented on 01.02.2016. No application for further investigation has been filed by the complainant.

In view of the said fact, the interim order 03.09.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
