Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.218 dated 11.07.2016 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code,1860, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, the petitioner was arrested on 03.06.2016 and is in jail since then.

The learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the counsel for the complainant both are present before the Court, they have stated that the compromise to some extent has been arrived at and the complainant would have no objection if the petitioner is being released on bail. At any rate, looking to the nature of the offence under Sections 406 and 420 is triable by the Magistrate. There is no reason in continuing the detention of the petitioner under trial. Trial will take its own time.

In that view of the matter, the petition for grant of bail is allowed.
Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Judge.
