By way of this second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118, dated 25.08.2013, registered under Sections 302, 307, 323 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code (for the 'the IPC') at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Co-accused, Gurpal Singh and Sandeep Singh have been admitted to bail by this Court.

Heard.

The first bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed by passing a detailed order dated 19.08.2016. Any relief granted to the

aforesaid co-accused will not have any bearing and cannot be construed as favourable circumstances in favour of the petitioner, therefore, no case for bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
