The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.363, dated 9.7.2016, registered under Section 379A of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for the last more than two months; it is a case of snatching of a mobile; there is no direct evidence, and the petitioner has clean antecedents.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the fact that it is a case of Magisterial trial, as well as the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
