Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.23 dated 09.01.2015 under Section 188 of IPC & Sections 263-A, 350-A of Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, registered at Police Station Mujessar, Faridabad.

This Court vide order dated 05.09.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. But on the adjourned date, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar, submitted that the petitioner has not joined investigation. Accordingly, vide order dated 29.11.2016, petitioner was directed to appear before the Investigating

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to orders dated 05.09.2016 and 29.11.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Ashwani Kumar has stated that in terms of above orders, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 05.09.2016 and 29.11.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
