Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 23.2.2016, under Sections 15/16/61/85 and 27-A of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City, Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recovery of 51 kilograms of poppy husk was effected from the car owned by co-accused Raj Kumar. She further states that the recovery is marginally higher than the commercial quantity and the co-accused namely Deepak Kumar and Arjun have already been admitted on bail by this Court in CRM-M No.26233 of 2016 titled 'Deepak Kumar @ Deepu vs. State of Haryana', decided on 8.8.2016 and CRM-M No.21398 of 2016 titled 'Arjun Singh vs.

State of Haryana' decided on 22.6.2016.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts and states that the co-accused have been admitted on bail by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is marginally high than the commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody since 23.2.2016 and co-accused have been admitted on regular bail by this Court. In view of the aforesaid facts, the instant petition for regular bail of the petitioner is hereby accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
