INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.84 dated 19.06.2016, registered at Police Station Rozka Meo, District Mewat, under Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has

been registered against the present petitioner and co-accused on the basis of secret information. The petitioner is stated to have run away from the spot. As per the FIR, only the secret informer has identified the present petitioner, but name of secret informer has not been mentioned therein.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 01.09.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. Nothing is to be recovered from him.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 01.09.2016 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
