By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the respondent Nos.2 & 3 for taking appropriate action on the complaint filed by him for registration of case against respondents No.4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 25.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a

direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
