The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.63 dated 02.06.2013, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 27.08.2016 (Annexure P-3).

On the last date of hearing, Mr.R.D.Rattewal, Advocate, had put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-Sandeep Kaur and accepted notice. He had also tendered an affidavit dated 05.09.2016, alongwith Votor Identity Card of respondent No.2 in Court, stating that she has amicably resolved all the disputes with the petitioner and both of them are happily residing in the company of each other for the last ten months, in the house of her parents at village Puadarha, Tehsil Phillaur District Jalandhar, and that

proceedings are quashed on the basis of compromise.

Keeping in view the affidavit of respondent No.2-Sandeep Kaur that both the parties are residing in the company of each other for the last ten months and respondent No.2-Sandeep Kaur has no objection if the impugned FIR is quashed qua the petitioner, FIR No.63 dated 02.06.2013, for the offence under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
