This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.91 dated 21.04.2015 registered under Sections 302/323/148/149 IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural).

On the last date the following order was passed :-

“The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since 22.04.2015.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from Investigating Officer, states that 5-6 official witnesses remain to be examined and instead of releasing the petitioner on bail, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial, and prays for an adjournment to place on record affidavit of the S.S.P. Jalandhar to the effect that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence by 30.11.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.

Adjourned to 10.11.2016.”

Learned Additional Advocate General states that though the affidavit has not been received yet she has been instructed that the prosecution will conclude its entire evidence by 30.11.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same).

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Additional Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.11.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
