This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.48, dated 20.05.2016 registered under Sections 307/452/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Shri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that other co-accused-Tarsem Singh has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 25.07.2016 passed in ***CRM-M-24020 of 2016***.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh has accepted this fact.

I see no reason to take a different view to that taken by this Court in the case of co-accused.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the investigating officer on 16.9.2016 and on any other date as and when their presence is required. On their appearance the I.O. shall release them on bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioners do not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.
