Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.240 dated 08.12.2015, under Sections 448, 456, 427 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural).

On 02.09.2016, while issue notice to the State, this Court had granted ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners. They were further directed to join the investigation on 17.09.2016.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sharanjit Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and at this stage are no longer needed by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 02.09.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
