INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.433 dated 04.12.2014, registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurgaon, under Sections 457, 396, 412 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Vikash Chopra, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, Luxman Singh, who was performing guard duty in Noorjahan Export Company, was found dead inside the premises of the company. His legs and hands were tied and a cloth was put in his mouth. When CCTV camera was operated, it was seen that 5-6 persons jumped through the wall of premises of company and that

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they were beating the guard. They were seen dragging the guard in the basement of building of the company. Thereafter in one vehicle, TATA-S of white colour, they were seen taking away the looted clothes. As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner has been challaned in this case and a bundle of clothes was also recovered from him.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that there is every apprehension that if the petitioner is released on regular bail, he may tamper with the evidence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since 15.12.2014, therefore, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if requires.
